

Tree species in Norway - instruction manual

Tree species in Norway (TRESLAG i Norge) is an app to determine tree species. Once downloaded, there is no need for Internet. The application is for free, and available for mobile phones and tablets on the App Store (iPhone and iPad) and Play Store (Android phones and tablets).

Twenty-seven of the most common tree species in Norway have been described with images from all four seasons, in addition to a short text. To enter the list of species, choose a season, or choose all seasons.

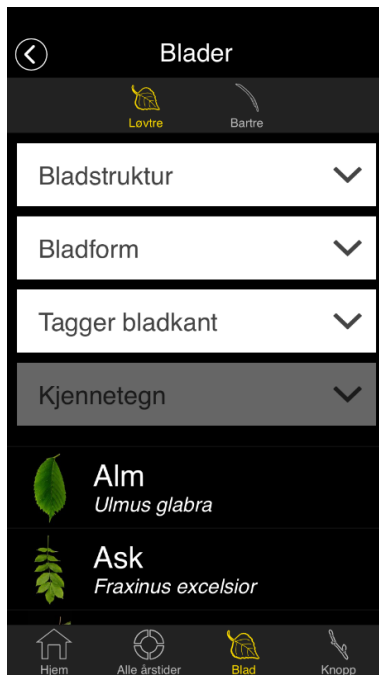

Identification keys

The alternative is to use the identification keys. They are available from the front page (*Nøkler*), and the choices are *Blader* (leaves) or *Knopp* (buds). The menu will guide you through the decision points. A list of species in accordance to your choices will appear at the bottom, and in the end only a few or one species will be left.

Leaves



Identification key for leaves

At the top, chose deciduous (løvtre) or coniferous trees (bartre).

For **deciduous** trees, the choices are:

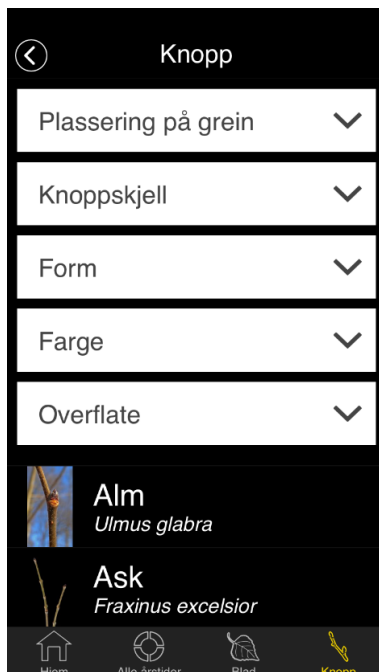
- Leaf structure
- Leaf shape
- Leaf margin
- Special characteristics*

**Special characteristics* is only available for some of the species.

For **coniferous** trees, the choices are:

- Arrangement on twig
- Shape of cross section
- Texture

Buds



Identification key for buds

Choices are:

- Arrangement of buds on twig
- Number of scales on each bud
- Shape of bud
- Colour of bud
- Surface of bud

Based on your choice, various other options will appear. After having decided on all possible options, the app will tell you which tree species the twig you are looking at belongs to.
